- 2. Read the local newspapers.
- 3. Sign up for email lists (For Mayor's office, local school, etc).
- 4. Network: identify who the influencers are in town. Get to know them.
- 5. Set up Google Alerts pertaining to your town, or area of interest and get electronically notified.
- 6. Attend the local meetings, or request minutes (or find online).
- 7. Attend local community events.
- 8. Ask to be put on snail mail newsletters.
- 9. Ask questions of leaders. Do not wait for the info to come to you go to them.
